As part of the NWU Business School's selection process, we incorporate a competence screening process in collaboration with GMAC (the Graduate Management Admission Council), a non-profit association of leading graduate business schools worldwide. GMAC offers both the GMAT and NMAT Admission Tests for entrance into graduate management programmes.

If you have previously done the GMAT, it will also be recognised by us (or anything similar) provided that is it not more than five years since you wrote it. The NWU Business School uses the NMAT Admission Test to select MBA candidates. The NMAT is administered by NCS Pearson, Inc. in various countries.

The NMAT Admission Test has three sections – language skills, quantitative skills and logical reasoning. It is a two-hour test containing multiple-choice questions.
