

❖ Overall aim

- Evaluate South Africa's utilisation of sustained export potential in SSA

❖ Secondary aims

- Determine which markets offer consistently large and/or growing import demand in SSA over a five-year period from 2010 to 2014
- Determine which products South Africa consistently export competitively over a five-year period from 2010 to 2014
- Identify sustained export opportunities that exists for SA in SSA
- Providing practical insights that will inform future policymaking and planning





■ Extinct





1.5 CONCLUSIONS AND RECOMMENDATIONS

❖ Conclusions

- SA is utilising 58% of its sustained export potential in SSA
 - ✓ Mostly in Eastern Africa
- SA is underutilising 21% of its sustained export potential in SSA
- SA is not utilising at all 21% of its sustained export potential in SSA
 - ✓ Mostly in Central and Western Africa

❖ Recommendations

- Investigating the reasons behind SA's under and non-utilisation of sustained export potential in SSA.
 - ✓ Future firm level research can be undertaken to broaden the understanding of the results obtained in this study.
