

ASPEN MBA BURSARY: 2018 (NWU School of Business & Governance)

The NWU School of Business & Governance is inviting students who qualify or have already qualified (and enrolled) for part-time MBA studies to apply for an annual bursary, to be awarded (early) in the 2016 academic year.

- Consideration will be given to South African students who:
 - have a proven record of good academic performance;
 - will eventually be *registered* as a MBA student at the NWU School of Business & Governance;
 - need financial aid for his/her MBA studies.
- Prospective applicants must submit the following portfolio of evidence:
 - a detailed curriculum vitae;
 - certified copies of qualifications and recent academic records;
 - a certified copy of a South African identity document;
 - confirmation of registration with the NWU School of Business & Governance or a letter of acceptance into NWU Business School's MBA programme;
 - proof of income (pay slip)
 - motivation as to why the bursary should be awarded to him/her;
- MBA studies of the applicant should under no circumstances be financed/sponsored directly or indirectly by his/her employer or any other institution (in part of fully).
