














POST-GRADUATE DIPLOMA IN MANAGEMENT

Duration and structure of the diploma

The diploma stretches over one academic year. Learners have to register for all five modules per semester. Each module consists of 15 contact hours.

Accessibility

The classes are presented in Afrikaans on weekdays in Potchefstroom (Full Time). Part time classes will be presented in English during break-away sessions.

Credit

The diploma carries a total weight of 12 credits on HEQF level 8. Each module has a weight of 12 credits.

Loyalty credit recognitions

The NWU School of Business & Governance's MBA selection panel can also give credit for three modules (Management economics, Corporate governance and Strategic talent management).
